**Supplies:**

*Please follow the supply list as closely as possible.* If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to call the school. It is not necessary to purchase new supplies each year. Any supplies from previous years in usable condition are acceptable. All supplies are to be brought on the **first day of school** as indicated below. This will make it easier for students to get organized in the classroom. Supplies not used immediately will be stored at school and dispensed as needed.

**Please ensure that all supplies are labeled with the student's name.** This includes pencils and pens. It is not necessary to label facial tissue, as this is a community item.

**General supplies checklist:**

<b>2</b>	1 inch binders
<b>6</b>	≈ 32 page notebooks (preferably stapled)
<b>1</b>	Package of dividers
<b>30</b>	Pencils (approximately)
<b>2</b>	Red pens
<b>2</b>	Pencil erasers (soft white are the best)
<b>1</b>	Pair of scissors
<b>2</b>	Highlighters
<b>1</b>	Calculator - basic functions – <b>NOT</b> a scientific calculator
<b>1</b>	Pencil sharpener (recommend good quality, self storing)
<b>1</b>	Metric ruler (with cm and mm markings)
<b>1</b>	Set of earphones (earbud style preferred for storage purposes)
<b>2</b>	Packages sticky notes (standard size)
<b>1</b>	Pencil case (for daily use)
<b>3</b>	Boxes of facial tissue
<b>1</b>	Back-pack style school bag for carrying supplies to and from school
<b>1</b>	Large glue stick
<b>1</b>	Bottle liquid glue
<b>1</b>	Dictionary (optional)
<b>1</b>	Combination lock for locker. Please have child memorize the combination and practice opening the lock at home. <b><i>Please email Mrs. Pieczonka the combination before the start of school.</i></b>
<b>\$5.00</b>	For teacher purchased supplies (duo tangs, reinforcements, white paper, cue cards, lined paper, etc.)

### **Art supplies**

	1	Package of fine/medium tip markers
	1	Package of pencil crayons
	2	Fine point black markers
	2	Black permanent markers
	1	Sketchbook (standard size – approx. 8 x 10)
	1	Pencil case to hold art supplies (of a reasonable size)

**French Supplies:** You may use last year's supplies if they are in good condition

	1	1 inch binder
	1	Three-hole pencil case ( <b>*put pencils, eraser and glue stick inside before bringing to school</b> )
	1	French/English dictionary
	1	Duo-tang (different in colour from general supplies list)
	5	Sharpened pencils (non-mechanical with no plastic coverings)
	1	Soft white pencil eraser
	1	Medium glue stick

**Gym Supplies:** Please label everything

	Outside pair of shoes <b>and</b> an inside pair of shoes (these should be proper runners with laces – indoor shoes need white non-marking soles). *During the fall and spring, Phys. Ed. Classes may be held outdoors. A suitable pair of outdoor shoes is required during these seasons.*	
	Grey gym shirt – purchased from school supplier	
	Blue gym shorts – purchased from school supplier	
	Gym bag – cloth drawstring bag to hang on a hook	
	Appropriate hygiene material – i.e. deodorant	

### **Uniform Reminder**

Please label all uniform clothing items so that they are easier to identify in the gym change rooms or lying around the classroom. Please protect your investment. Our lost and found fills up very quickly with shoes and clothing that are often left unclaimed.

A number of students are choosing not to purchase uniform hoodies/fleeces. The classrooms can be quite cool, especially in the spring and fall.
